



Lee's Summit High School Parking Rules 2017-18

Students who park in the student parking lots must consider this a privilege and it can be revoked. In order for students to drive to school and park in the student lot, students must obtain a parking permit and display this decal properly. The school district is not responsible for damage or accidents that occur to students' vehicles on school property. Beginning at registration, all eligible students will have the opportunity to purchase an individual parking permit for \$10.00. Violations of parking rules may result in a \$20.00 fine. Students should be aware that the administration may search their vehicle for security, safety reasons, or for suspicion of violating school rules. Students must be insured and carry a valid driver's license.

Parking Rules and Regulations

****New for 2017-2018 School Year:** Students will be asked to park "head-in" each parking spot. Students will not be allowed to back into parking spots; therefore, the rear of the vehicle must face the driving lane.**

1. Students must be age 16 or older and have a valid driver's license. Failure to display your decal or an improperly displayed permit are subject to ticketing.
2. Students must have purchased a valid parking permit. Students parked on school grounds who have not purchased a parking permit or fail to display their decal properly will be subject to the following penalties:
 - 1st offense - Student Warning
 - 2nd offense - \$20.00 Fine
 - 3rd offense - \$20.00 Fine and Parent Contact
 - 4th offense - \$20.00 Fine and Parent Contact/Five-day parking permit revocation
3. Students must park in designated "Student Parking Areas". Tickets and/or towing at owner's expense will occur without warning to students parking in any of the following unauthorized manners:
 - Parking in Handicapped, Visitors, or Fire zones.
 - Parking in staff parking areas.
 - Vehicles not parked within the painted yellow lines.
 - Parking on grassy areas.
4. The speed limit on campus is 15 mph. Please observe all traffic patterns, rules, and regulations. Reckless or careless driving may result in loss of parking privileges.
5. Students may not sit in parked cars on school grounds before or after school.
6. Students may not go to their cars during the school day without administrator permission.
7. **LOCK YOUR CAR!** Students are responsible for the security of their belongings and parking permit! If lost or stolen, a new permit must be purchased for \$5.00. Students should report lost or stolen parking permits to the school main office or student administration immediately. Students found using a lost, stolen, or borrowed permit may lose their parking privileges.
8. Once a student has accumulated \$60.00 or more in Parking Fines, the student's parking privileges will be revoked until restitution is made.
9. Students who have inadvertently parked at school without their parking permit should advise the main office to avoid being issued a parking ticket for that day.
