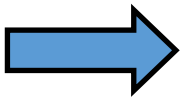
2022-2023 Early College Program Enrollment Checklist



STEP 1 & 2: Speak with your high school counselor to determine if the Early College Program is a good fit for you. If yes, complete the following:

- 1) Click the link to complete the free, online application for Metropolitan Community College at <https://mckc.edu/apply-now/>. The application must be completed at least 2 business days prior to taking the ACCUPLACER Test (see below testing information).
- 2) Click the link to complete and submit the [LSR7 Early College Program application](#)

Priority Deadline: February 28, 2022



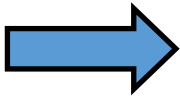
STEP 3: Provide a copy of your ACT scores or completed ACCUPLACER placement scores.

The ACCUPLACER is available by appointment at MCC-Longview.

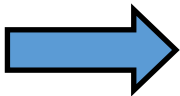
[Testing Center](#) call 816-604-1000 to

schedule an appointment. Please note, you must have a MCC ID # (received after application completion) and a picture ID to test. The following site is recommended for test preparation: <https://accuplacer.collegeboard.org/student/practice>

Required ACT scores: ENGL– 18, READ– 18(composite), MATH– 22 (only if enrolling in math course) Required ACCUPLACER scores: Test into ENGL 101, Read 100 or above, and MATH 120 (only if enrolling in math course)



STEP 4: Meet with a MCC Academic Advisor at the LSR7 Enrollment Conferences to discuss MCC class registration. (March 8-10)



STEP 5: Attend the Early College Program Orientation (TBD). Students & parent/guardian will receive their final schedule, campus tour and other important information.



STEP 6: Make tuition payment arrangements. First payment for the fall semester is due July 15, 2022
