# LSHS 2023-24: ITEMS TO CELEBRATE!


 On May 17, LSHS graduated 453 outstanding seniors.


 2024 graduates accepted over \$3 million dollars in scholarships. 82 finished high school with a 4.0 or higher cumulative GPA. 18 were named Bright Flight Scholars. 70% are headed to college or some type of post-secondary education, 7 graduates will serve in the military, while 9% will enter the world of work.

 15 LSHS staff members were candidates for Lee's Summit R7's Teacher and Support Professional of the Year program, and Communication Arts teacher Elaine McDonald was awarded with the LSR7 Excellence Award.

 Across the 8 years of its existence, KC Scholars has awarded \$50,000 scholarships to 57 LSHS Tigers, totaling over \$2.6 million in awards.

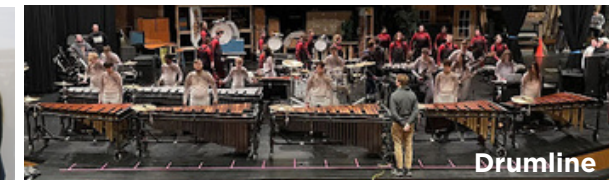
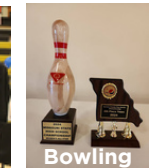
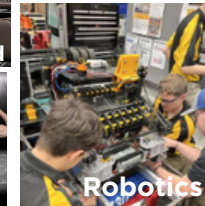
 Some highlights include: LSHS Boys Cross Country finished 6th in the state. Boys Swim finished 8th at state with several individual all state athletes. Boys and Girls Track earned 5 state medals. The Reflector Yearbook was a finalist for the National Pacemaker award. Drumline placed 2nd at state. Seven LSHS Music students earned All-State Honors. Robotics Team Driven competed at the World competition in Houston and also won various awards during the year. LSHS Bowling team finished 4th at the state competition.

 Tigers won 3 District Championships: Girls Basketball, Boys Basketball, and Girls Soccer. LSHS Girls Soccer program finished with a 3rd place medal in the state of Missouri. Tigerettes finished 11th in the nation at the medium varsity dance competition in Orlando. LSHS saw 31 students sign letters of intent to compete at the collegiate level.

 The LSHS AFJROTC Flying Tigers had an outstanding year. The corps crushed its triennial inspection from Headquarters garnering 16 "Exceeds Standards" ratings. The competition Teams (Drill and Raiders) won a total of 12 trophies in addition to numerous individual awards. Cadets rode helicopters and toured an Air Force Base. On average, cadets accomplished 28 hours of community service and represented the school in numerous public events around the KC metro area.

Mr. Muckey is beginning his first year as Principal at LSHS. He previously served as Principal at Lone Jack High School and Assistant Principal in the Independence School District .

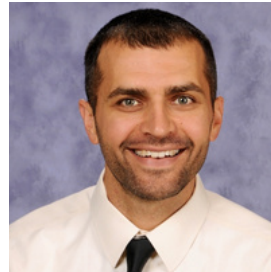
Mr. Muckey is excited to be back home at his Alma Mater - It's A Great Day To Be A Tiger (again)!

She previously taught and coached Volleyball in the Park Hill and Independence School Districts.



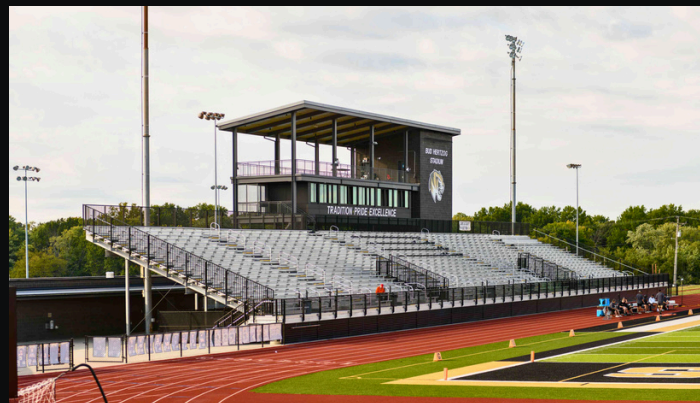
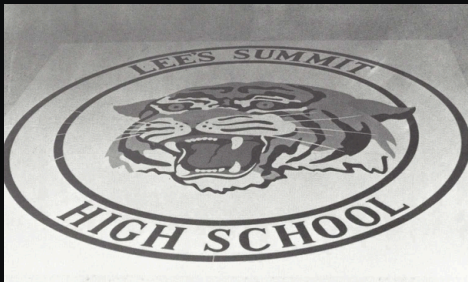
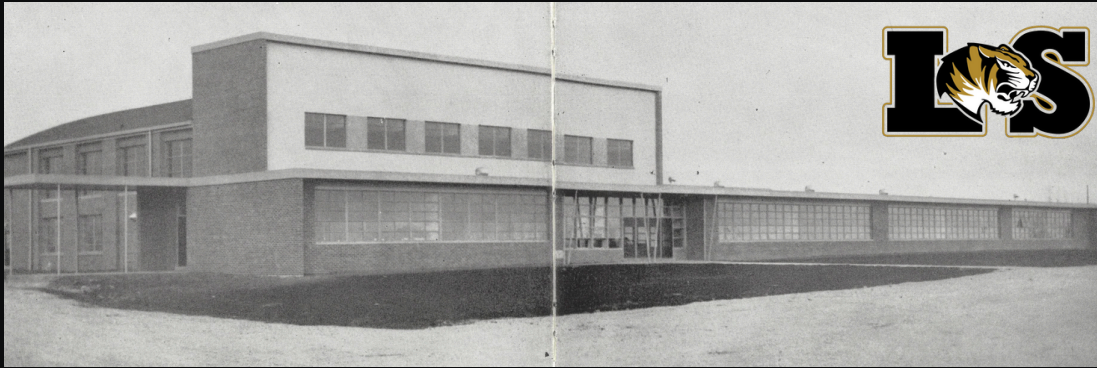
**Dr. Shawn Sotheran**

## PREPPING FOR EXAM SEASON

Standardized tests begin in April and continue through May. These include Missouri End-of-Course exams, International Baccalaureate exams, and Advanced Placement exams. This can be a difficult and stressful time for students. As an adult supporter, here are a few ways to help your student perform to the best of their ability and manage the additional stress:

- Begin reviewing and studying material early, ideally at least 2 weeks prior to the exam date.
- Study small chunks of information each day.
- Focus on healthy sleep habits. Teenagers should get 9-10 hours of sleep each night. This is critical to physical and mental health, as well as academic performance.
- Fuel the body with healthy food choices, including plenty of water, fruits, and vegetables. A typical teen diet of pop, chips, caffeine, and sugar does not best support the body and brain.
- Monitor your teen for stress overload. If your student is struggling, don't hesitate to address it with them, and cut back on some activities to de-stress your child.



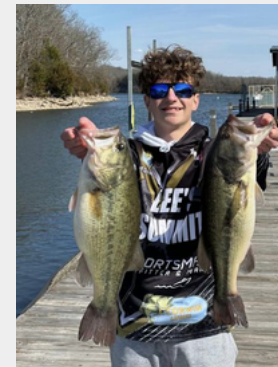
